# 3 on 3 Tournament: Rules

## Section I: Game Play

1. All 3 on 3 games are **NON-CONTACT**
2. **Clock** – Will run continuously for 30 minutes without stoppage. 3 minute warm-up, 1<sup>st</sup> period: 15mins, 2<sup>nd</sup> period: 15mins
3. ICINGS are **not called** in games
4. TWO-LINE PASSES are **not called**
5. NO OFFSIDES are **not called**
6. Face-offs occur at the beginning of each period at center ice.
7. Teams will switch ends at the end of period 1.
8. Line Changes: Line changes will be done **“on the fly”**.
9. **Change of possession:**
  - i) **OUT OF PLAY** – When the puck goes out of play, the team not responsible for the stoppage in play will be awarded the puck. A minimum of ten feet of clearance shall be given to resume play. No face-off will occur.
  - ii) **DELAY OF GAME:** A penalty shot will be award against the team purposely delaying the game time to run out the clock.
  - iii) **GOAL SCORED** – When a goal is scored, the scoring team is required to retreat back past center ice (refer will coach scoring team out of zone) until the puck is brought forward past the goalie by the team scored upon. If the scoring team intentionally touches the puck prior to clearing the blue line, a penalty shot will be awarded. A team clearing the puck after being scored upon has only 10 seconds to proceed past their net, or a delay of game penalty will be called.
  - iv) **NO GOALIES:** Players may block shots on net. A tutor shooter will be in net for each team.
10. **Timeouts** – Each team will be awarded one 30 second timeout during each game.
11. **Round Robin Stage:** The first stage of the 3 on 3 Tournament is a round robin. The top eight teams with the most wins will move on to the playoff round. If there is eight teams or less in the tournament all teams will go one to the playoff round.

## Section II – Roster and Eligibility Rules

1. NO more than 6 skaters can be dressed for any given game – no exceptions.
2. A team must have a minimum of 4 players dressed for a game to avoid default.
3. Under no circumstances can a player who is not registered on a team play in the 3 on 3 tournament

## Section III – Penalties

1. All minor penalties will result in a penalty shot.

### Penalty Shot Procedure

1. When a penalty is called, the clock will not stop.
2. Penalty shot must be taken by one of the players on the ice at the time of the infraction.
3. The player taking the penalty shot will line up at centre ice and will shoot from centre ice. (No moving towards net)
4. All other players from both teams will line up beside (giving enough space for penalty shot player) the player taking the penalty shot.
5. All players will start from a standing position.

Referee will blow the whistle to start play. No other players on ice can start skating until the player taking the penalty shot has shot the puck. If a goal is scored, players must clear the zone as normal.

6. Coincidental minor penalties will result in no penalty shots for either team. Coincidental minor penalties will result in a face-off at centre ice.
7. A major penalty (major penalty offences listed below) will result in the offending player(s) ejection from the game and a penalty shot will be awarded.
  - a. Any action and/or communication by any player on the ice that breaks the code of conduct that is described in Sections 4 below.
  - b. Fighting
8. Under no circumstances will fighting be permitted in 3 on 3. Expulsion from the Tournament may result. A player suspended or expelled from the Tournament for any reason will not be entitled to any awards their team may receive.
9. During the course of the game, the referee's decision is final.

#### **Section IV – Code of Conduct**

1. Code of conduct – Village Recreation identifies the standard of behavior that is expected of all 3 on 3 hockey tournament members which, for the purpose of this code includes players, coaches, volunteers and spectators. Village Recreation is committed to providing an environment in which all individuals are treated with respect. All members shall avoid behavior which brings Village Recreation and the sport of hockey into disrepute, including but not limited to abusive use of alcohol, use of non-medically prescribed drugs and use of alcohol by minors. Members shall refrain from comments or behavior that is disrespectful, offensive, abusive, racist or sexist. In particular, behavior which constitutes harassment or abuse will not be tolerated. Failure to comply with this Code of Conduct may result in disciplinary action.
